NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Standard Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2024 VSGA Championships)

TEE MARKERS:

Mid-Senior – Green VSGA Tee Markers; 65 and over – Gold VSGA Tee Markers
70 and over – White VSGA Tee Markers; 75 and over – Red VSGA Tee Markers

FORMAT: Singles match play. If a match is tied after 18 holes, the match will return to starting hole. The round is extended until a hole is won.

OUT OF BOUNDS: In addition to the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes, white lines, and fence posts, out of bounds is also defined by the course side edge of all public roads and the parking lots. The maintenance fence on the left side of hole #3 defines Out of Bounds. If stakes and the edge of public roads occur at the same time, the stakes are used to define Out of Bounds.

DROPPING ZONE – Hole #4: If, during play of hole #4, a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball has not been found lies in the Yellow Penalty Area, the player may:
i. proceed under Rule 17 or 16.1; or
ii. as an additional option, drop a ball under penalty of one stroke in the Dropping Zone located on the Green Teeing Area, approximately 69 yards from the Putting Green.

INTEGRAL OBJECTS - Stone Walls: Stone walls adjacent to teeing areas are played as integral objects. Players do not get free relief.

OBSTRUCTION - Clubhouse: The clubhouse, patio area, and adjacent flower beds are all one obstruction.

FADED PAINT LINES: Please disregard any faint paint lines on the course. They have no meaning for this tournament.

CADDIES/TRANSPORTATION: Players may have a caddie and caddies may ride in carts only if there is a seat available. Spectators (outside agencies) may ride in carts if there is a seat available.

PACE OF PLAY: Please refer to the VSGA Standard Local Rules, and VSGA.org for the complete pace of play policy.

PLAYOFF/TIES: In match play, any match tied after 18 holes will go extra holes until a winner is determined.

SCORING: The digital scorecard used via the Golf Genius app is the unofficial scorecard. The official scorecard is the paper scorecard which needs to be verified in the scoring area (located on the patio area behind the 18th green).
