

What is a One-Day Event?

VSGA One-Day Events are individual stroke play competitions open to golfers of all ages and abilities. Select events on the 2026 schedule are marked as Impact Events. A portion of the entry fee for Impact Events supports the VSGA's junior programs.

What is the entry fee?

One-Day Events are \$70 per player, per day. Impact Events are \$95 per player, per day.

Who can register?

Participants must have an active Handicap Index issued by a VSGA member club. You can view VSGA membership options [here](#).

When does registration open?

All One-Day Events will open for lottery registration on Wednesday, February 11 at 11:00 am and will close on Thursday, February 12 at 11:59 pm. Any event that reaches maximum capacity will use a randomized lottery to select the field. Players not selected will be placed on a waitlist.

Both confirmed and waitlisted players will receive an email notification of their status by 5:00 pm on Friday, February 13.

After the initial lottery period, events with available space will reopen and accept registrations on a first-come, first-served basis until the event's posted registration deadline.

What is the format?

Individual stroke play. Players are flighted by Handicap Index. Tees are assigned based on fixed age ranges. Tees played may vary depending on the host club's availability, and in some cases multiple age ranges may play from the same tees. The tee guidelines below apply to only those who wish to compete for prizes. A player may play a longer set of tees and be eligible for prizes. If a player decides to play a shorter set of tees, the player will not be eligible for prizes. If you choose to play a different set of tees, you must notify the staff member on site before teeing off.

Approximate yardages are:

- Men 49 & under – 6,200-6,400
- Men 50-64 – 6,000-6,200
- Men 65-74 – 5,700-5,900
- Men 75-79 – 5,400-5,900
- Men 80 & over – 4,800-5,300
- Ladies – 4,800-5,200

Can I request a grouping?

Yes. A field is provided during registration to enter grouping requests. Requests may also be added after registration by editing your event registration or by contacting the VSGA.

What is the Tournament of Champions and how do I qualify?

The Tournament of Champions is the season-ending One-Day Championship. The field is determined using One-Day Player Rankings points. Players who finish in the top 100 of the rankings are invited to register for the Championship.

How do you earn One-Day Player Rankings points?

Points are awarded based on your overall net finish in each One-Day Event.

What is the refund and credit policy?

Refunds may be processed online or by contacting the VSGA office. Refund requests must be submitted at least seven days prior to the event and are subject to a \$10 administrative fee.

Credits and/or transfers must be requested by contacting the VSGA at least three days prior to the event. All credits must be used by the final event of the current season and do not carry over to future years.

How are scoring and prizes handled?

The VSGA will post all scores to GHIN following each event. Prizes are awarded in the form of gift certificates redeemable at the host club's golf shop. Prizes are awarded for both gross and net winners in all flights.

What is the weather cancellation policy?

VSGA One-Day Events are held rain or shine. Any cancellations due to inclement weather are typically not decided until the morning of the event. Changes to the event schedule will be communicated to players via email.

Are caddies allowed?

Yes, caddies are permitted; however, cart availability cannot be guaranteed. Caddies must walk unless there is an empty seat in the cart.
